



MS/HS Cell Phone Procedures 2024-2025

Students may bring their cell phones to school and are permitted to use them appropriately when classes are not in session. Cell phones are not allowed in the classrooms and should be stored in student lockers if brought into the school building. Students will be allowed to use cell phones between classes and during lunch times. Students are not permitted to take photos or videos of other students or staff members without permission.

Consequences for Violation of Cell Phone Procedure Per Class

- 1st Offense: Warning. Student is sent to the office. No referral is needed. The teacher will contact the parent of the student. The phone will be put in the student's locker.
- 2nd Offense: Student is sent to the Main Office. A referral is submitted to Mrs. Dupuis by the teacher. The teacher will contact the parent of the student. The phone is kept in the Main Office until the end of the day. The student will serve an after school principal's detention.
- 3rd Offense: Student is sent to the Main Office. A referral is submitted to Mrs. Dupuis by the teacher. Mrs. Dupuis will contact the parent. The student's phone will be kept in the Main Office until the end of the day. The student will serve a day in ALC.
- 4th Offense or Higher: Student is sent to the Main Office. A referral is submitted to Mrs. Dupuis by the teacher. Mrs. Dupuis will contact the parent. The student's phone will be kept in the Main Office until the end of the day. The student will serve multiple days of ALC or out of school suspension as determined by Mrs. Dupuis.
