COVID-19 RESPONSE: Quarterly Grades and New Material

Quarterly Grades

- Quarter 3 Grades
 - Quarter 3 grades will be finalized based on the seven weeks of instruction and assessed material collected through March 13th
 - No student will receive a grade less than a 50
 - Students will have the opportunity to finish any missed or incomplete work during the entire time the traditional classes are cancelled
- Quarter 4 Grades
 - Grades for Quarter 4 will not be determined until classes resume
 - Teachers will be collecting materials electronically (*ie. Google Classroom, emailing pictures, etc.*) and reviewing them for “evidence of learning”
- College Courses
 - College Courses are continuing as normal through remote learning (*college decision*) and will follow the guidelines for grading established by the college

New Materials

New Learning Expectations: *When introducing new materials, we will*

- Prioritize the New York State Learning Standards that are essential to the foundation for future learning;
- Provide direct support from the teacher (i.e. Google Hang-out; YouTube Video);
- Ensure that students are able to complete the work independently at home;
- Ensure that the work can be completed with minimal resources;
- Ensure that the utilized platforms are universally available or that options provided for different platforms;

Time Expectations:

- UPK: 2 Hours per week
- Grades Kindergarten - 2nd: 3.5 Hours per week
 - 1.25 Hours for ELA;
 - 1.25 Hours for Math;
 - 1 Hour for Specials;
- Grades 3 - 5: 5 Hours per week
 - 2 Hours for ELA;
 - 2 Hours for Math;
 - 1 Hours for Specials
- Grades 6 - 8: 10 Hours per week
 - 2 Hours for ELA
 - 2 Hours for Math
 - 2 Hours for Science
 - 2 Hours for Social Studies
 - 2 Hours for Specials
- Grades 9 - 12: 2 - 2.5 hours per course, per week
