- The last late bus will be on June 12th.
- The last day of classes for students in grades 7-12 will be on Monday, June 16th.
- Students in grades K-12 will have an early dismissal at 11:45 on Monday, June 16th.
- Students in grades 9-12 who do not have a scheduled Regents, should not report to school unless they are working with a teacher.
- Lunch will be served from 11:15 a.m -11:45 p.m. for any student who has an afternoon exam.
- There will be an extra 11:45 a.m bus run on June 17th, 18th, and 20th for those students with only a morning exam. Please have your child sign up in the main office if your child will need transportation on these dates at 11:45.
- The regular 2:30 p.m. bus run will continue through June 20th.
- There will be an 11:45 a.m. bus run on June 23rd through June 26th.
- There will be a 2:30 p.m. bus run for the afternoon regents exam on June 24th.
- Students who do not complete an exam by 2:30 will have to provide their own transportation home.
- Students who arrive early for an exam and/or finish an exam early and need transportation, must report to the assigned classroom until bus dismissal.
- All Regents exams will be held in the gymnasium except for Geometry, Algebra II and Physics.
