

## Remote Learning Plan for Middle/High School Students

- ❑ Students in grades 6-8 will be remote on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and scheduled Fridays.
- ❑ Students in grades 9-12 will be remote on Mondays, Tuesdays, and scheduled Fridays.

### Student Expectations on Remote Learning Days:

- Students will be expected to follow their assigned class schedule as if they were in the building and engage in learning activities.
- Students will be required to connect online daily using Google Classroom, period by period, to receive instruction from their teachers. Attendance will be taken and failure to log in and keep camera on at all times will be counted and reported as an absence.
- Students will follow the Code of Conduct.
- Students will seek help when needed from teachers, counselors, and principal.

### Teacher Expectations on Remote Learning Days:

- Teachers will utilize Google Classroom for each course/class.
- Teachers will be online at that same time as their students providing instruction and collaboration activities. For example, Google Meets, lectures, presentations, discussions, chats, video conferencing, etc.
- Teachers will keep classes a minimum of thirty minutes, but may not exceed the forty minute class period.
- Teachers will notify parents/guardians of attendance issues or lack of engagement.

On remote learning days students will not be required to connect online to the following classes:

- Study Halls
- PE-Students will maintain independent PE Log
- Band-Individual virtual lessons can be scheduled during this period
- Chorus-Individual virtual lessons can be scheduled during this period
- ELA Labs-Teacher office hours/extra help to be offered during this period
- Math Labs-Teacher office hours/extra help to be offered during this period
- Writing Skills-Teacher office hours/extra help to be offered during this period
