Quarter 4 Grades

- There will be no numerical grades for Quarter 4
- Teachers will still provide assignments. The assignments will be assessed as evidence of learning
  - The evidence of learning will be evaluated and entered into SchoolTool as:
    - “Expectations Exceeded”
    - “Expectations Met”
    - “Expectations Not Met”
    - “Work Not Submitted”
- Course work expectations should continue to follow the district established guidelines
- Final Quarter 4 grades will be reflective of “Expectations Met” or “Expectations Not Met”

Overall Grades

- Middle/High School
  - Final averages will be determined using the combined averages of Quarters 1, 2, and 3.
    - Teachers will have the ability to give up to 5 additional points on a student’s final average based on the level of engagement throughout the period of closure.
  - High School Students: For those students who had a failing grade based on Quarters 1, 2, and 3 and did not engage during the period of closure:
    - The student will advance if they successfully attend summer school (if available) or complete a credit recovery program
    - The student will repeat the course if they do not participate in a summer program or do not successfully complete the summer program
  - Middle School Students: Students who had a failing grade based on Quarters 1, 2, and 3 will be discussed on a case-by-case basis with Mrs. Dupuis and the Guidance Office
- Elementary Students
  - The third trimester descriptors will remain blank and teachers will only include comments
