PROCESS

- 1. Create a District Instructional Technology Plan (*NYSED* approved in January 2016)
- 2. Public Hearing / Presentation
- 3. BOE Plan Approval
- 4. Plan submission for SED review and approval
- 5. Expenditure and Reimbursement of Funds

PRELIMINARY PLAN

PHASE 1

- •High-Tech Security Features
 - ✓ Replace 28 existing Analog Security Cameras with Digital Cameras
 - ✓ Install 12 new Digital Cameras, including software and recording devices
 - ✓ Install telephones in the Elementary and Middle/High Office vestibules
 - ✓ Install an exterior communication system for the Technology Building
 - ✓ Add six analog phones to the existing telephone system

Project Cost: \$103,000

PHASE 1

- •Classroom Learning Technology
 - ✓ Install 45 interactive projectors, replacing existing "SmartBoard" technology

Projected Cost: \$94,000
